

Texas A&M Maritime Academy Request for MART/MARE484 Internship

Cadets, their families, and/or friends are welcome to contact companies, vessels, or unions directly for billets. In order to sail commercially, prior approval of your billet must be obtained by the Texas A&M Maritime Academy. Failure to obtain approval will result in your sea time not counting. To obtain approval, cadets are required to submit vessel specifications to the Academy Sea Term Coordinator to determine if the vessels meet program requirements for sea time.

ELIGIBILITY

Cadet are eligible if:

- Conduct: Cadets must be in good standing with the University and the Corps of Cadets to be eligible for MART/MARE 484.
- Academic: Must have completed all prerequisite courses for MART/MARE 200 and successfully completed MART/MARE 200 to enroll in MART/MARE 484.
- License: Cadets must maintain a valid* MMC, medical certificate, USCG physical, and passport to be eligible for enrollment in MART/MARE 484. * Valid means the document does not expire within a year of the end of the internship.
