Lowell serves the University as the Assistant Department Head of Maritime Business Department, coordinates the exchange partnership with Copenhagen Business School, the undergraduate internship program and the Mara minor with Maritime Transportation. He is the MARA representative to the Academic Appeals committee as well as numerous subcommittees.
